cars and trams to be removed


The brief team of academic planners and architects recommended preliminary action:

- ✓ A two-stage process to undertake: urban concept + urban design






The *Re-animatori* architectural group of Varna I 2

The *Reanimate the Square* Project was the first project which subsequently gave the name of the Re-animatori foundation. A social experiment in which architects challenged citizens to appropriate the public space. This project was implemented with the assistance of the Chamber of Architects in Bulgaria, Varna Regional College and Varna European Youth Capital 2017.

Reanimate the Square Project

"With this intervention in the urban environment, the "Re-animatori" team is looking for revival of the relationship Architect – Artist – Society".



The project was nominated by the independent Varna media as a publicly significant project and in December 2017 won the Media AwARTs Award.

A Plein Air - Youth Architectural Competition initiated by the Chamber of Architects in Bulgaria financed by Varna European Youth Capital 2017.

The Re-animatori architectural group of Varna | 3

Special topics of the plein air were public spaces, silhouettes and tourist routes which were analyzed. Fifteen young architects took part into the *Plein Air*, they were consulted by renowned local specialists. They developed four strategies for the development of the area, solutions for the vision of the public spaces, possible adaptation to young people's needs and to the specifics of the future demographic processes. The developments were publicly discussed and submitted to Varna Municipality.























LESSONS LEARNED?

- Culture is a multilayered component in the urban process with multiple interacting dimensions, tangible and intangible;
- ✓ Urban memory is not to be taken for granted, it is continually regenerated or lost; it is value-based and needs to be shared with/by living people individuals and communities in building urban culture
- ✓ The material traces left in the urban environment carry visible messages to
 the present day and to the future; behind that there has been processes of
 searching and arguing, clashes of ideas, values and concerns that remain
 largely unrecorded and are possibly lost.
- ✓ Educating a greater sensitivity to the continuity of the urban process is a shared responsibility in the long term but also a persistent everyday effort for all of us - as professionals and citizens.
