

THE REGULATION OF THE "GDAŃSKIE QUESTY" MOBILE APPLICATION

1. The regulation concerns the electronically supplied services provided by: **Gdańsk Tourism Organisation** located in Gdańsk (80-530), Uczniowska 22 Street, NIP 5832887298, REGON: 192882979, hereinafter referred to as "the Service Supplier".

The regulation referred above, is considered to be the regulation within the meaning of article 8 of the Law of 18 July 2002, concerning the electronically supplied services (Journal of Laws 2013, item 1422).

2. Services provided by "Gdańskie Questy" Application in particular consist of:

- handling quests, i.e. field games
- popularisation of questing as a novel form of cognitive tourism
- enhancing the attractiveness of the region
- the possibility of participating in gamification,
- sending *Push* information with the new functionalities of the mobile application.

3. The Application can be downloaded from the internet store:

- a. App Store (for the iOS system),
- b. Google Play (for the Android system)

3a. The application, same as the quests included, will be available in 4 language versions: Polish, English, German and Russian one. The user will have the possibility of choosing the language.

3b. Downloading of the Application from the stores mentioned above as well as using the services offered by it is free of charge. The abovementioned does not exclude the necessity to pay a fee for the entrance to some historical facilities such as the Main City Hall.

3c. The costs of data transmission needed for downloading, launching and using the Application are covered by its users on their own, on the basis of the agreements concluded with a telecommunications carrier or the other Internet provider. The service supplier is not responsible for the costs charged for the use of the transmission of data, essential for using the Application. The Service Supplier is not responsible for the costs charged for using the application or for the functions of the operating system, responsible for counting the transmitted data.

3d. The Service Supplier is not responsible for the limitations or technical issues in Communication and Information systems which are used by the users' mobile devices, and which prevent or limit the users from using the Application and the services offered by it.

4. The User, within the meaning of this regulation, is a natural person who, with the "Gdańskie Questy" mobile application, installed on the user's mobile device, uses the functionalities offered by the application.

5. In order to use the Gdańskie Questy application, the Internet connection is necessary.

6. The application contains the group of quests. The riddles included in it may take a form of text questions, audio files, graphic files or objects in augmented reality. The answers to the riddles will be given in a form of a multiple choice test (4 possible answers). After checking the right answer, the User receives the clues on getting to another point. If the answer is wrong, the User can use a hint. In that situation, the User gets less points for the right answer. In the last point of each quest there is a "treasure" in a form of a personalised diploma for finishing the quest, with the possibility of the publication on social media.

7. Gdańsk Tourism Organisation hereby declares that taking part in the gamification, which is one of the functionalities of "Gdańskie Questy" application, results in processing of the User's personal data by the Service Supplier. Collecting, processing and using this data by the Service Supplier is necessary

for the verification of the User gamification in a moment of its termination, that is collecting the prize. The Service Supplier will also be using personal data of the Users for marketing purposes. By accepting this regulation, the User declares that they permit the processing of their personal data by the Gdańsk Tourism Organisation as stated above, and that they were informed that they have the right of access to their personal data and the right to have any such data that is inaccurate or incomplete rectified.

8. This Regulation is only complementary to the privacy policy of Google Play and Appstore. The Service Supplier is not responsible for the privacy policy of Google Play and Appstore and for obeying the Law on personal data protection and the Law on providing the electronically supplied services within the markets of Google Play and Appstore.

9. The user can stop using the “Gdańskie Questy” application at any time, by permanent removal of the application from their mobile device.

10. The materials shared by the “Gdańskie Questy” application, particularly texts, pictures, film and audio materials, compilations and databases are the property of the Service Supplier.

11. Users are obliged to use the Application in compliance to the existing law, the Regulation, and the regulations of the stores from which the application was downloaded as well to the rules of social coexistence, including the general rules of using the Internet network and mobile applications.

12. The Service Supplier has the right to change the Regulation at any time. The changes in the Regulation are valid from the moment of including them in the Application. Changes are believed to be accepted by the User in the moment of using the Application.

13. The final interpretation of Regulation belongs to the Service Supplier. In cases of dispute, the decision of the Service Supplier is final. The ignorance of the regulation does not mean that the participant is released from following it. For any matters not regulated by this Regulations, the following provisions of the Polish Law, particularly the Civil Code, shall apply; the Law of 18 July 2002 concerning the electronically supplied services.
